
The Promotion Officer of Serena, Suen Bok Nga Bianca, was introducing herself and her working partner, Kwok Ka Yui, on the stage.

The rain from the clear sky formed a crystal in the middle of the logo. Dr. Au-Yeung has been really active in different fields. Throughout the years, she has always pushed herself to predict what will be demanded by the society in 5 to 10 years. Apart from how meaningful it is to help with people in need, since she, at that time, realized that the need of human health care was everlasting, that could ensure the knowledge learnt could be useful and up-to-date in the future for decades, she decided to study for a PhD in MSE and chose Biotechnology and BioScience on heart disease as her research topic. At the moment, Dr. Au-Yeung is working on ensuring customers' safety when using different products through Biotechnology in multiple Science and Technology research institutes and organizations. Besides, Dr. Au-Yeung has also brought some new concepts to different fields in society and tried her best to make Hong Kong a better place to live and study. Since she has great passion towards green living and she has always been thinking of how to balance between protecting the environment and maintaining the standard quality of living, she established an online trading platform, Dun Dum, for people to trade their second-handed furniture in 2015 and successfully enhanced people's awareness and willingness towards environmental sustainability and reusing furniture respectively. Other than introducing environmentally-friendly lifestyles, she also devoted a lot to education, youth development and woman empowerment. To Dr. Au-Yeung, it is a sense of responsibility to contribute to these areas as she had benefited a lot from her mentors, teachers and a lot of established seniors in the past. She was shocked by how easy it was to start a company, and as a result, she realized that challenges are only scary and difficult if she does not take them or start working on them. For the challenges encountered when working as a leader in a team, to Dr. Au-Yeung, they are to make the best decisions, help teammates excel their strengths and maintain a friendly and encouraging atmosphere in a team. She suggested that a leader should trust and delicate tasks to the teammates and empower the teammates to unleash their potential to make them feel fulfilled in the team and become more willing to work for their leader, instead of taking up all the workload.

A Leader, Not A Pleaser

Successful leaders listen to the opinions of teammates and the outside world, but most importantly, they bounce back from sharp criticisms and make decisions rationally. Dr. Au-Yeung always asks her teammates to voice out their concerns and discontent during the first 10 minutes of the team meetings. She values the ideas and feelings of each and every teammate a lot. She believes that the opinions can definitely help her better understand the situations and think of what can be done or done better. Before discussing how to handle criticisms and personal attacks, Dr. Au-Yeung emphasized that it is fair play for leaders to take achievements, receive appreciation from others and bear criticisms and negative comments. There are two sides to every coin. Therefore, leaders should be mentally prepared to be criticized. When there are criticisms, one, as a leader, may feel discouraged and sad. However, never should leaders let the criticisms and negativity bother themselves for too long and please everyone in or out of the team. A great leader always recovers quickly and continues carrying out plans for the best outcome.
