S1 English Lessons

- 4 classes will be divided into 6 groups according to students' English levels
- 1A, 1B, 1AB
- 1C, 1D, 1CD
- About 20-22 students in 1 group
- Small class teaching
=> more teacher-student interactions
=> smaller learner diversity


